

# Proof of Live-in Caregiver Checklist



Manitoba Housing requires the following documents to support a request to have a live-in caregiver reside with a tenant.

To be approved for a live-in caregiver, a tenant must be assessed by Manitoba Health as requiring level 4 care.

A live-in caregiver is a person who is required to live with and provide care for a tenant. The caregiver must be approved to receive the Primary Caregiver Tax Credit.

## Tenant must provide all of the following documentation:

- Medical Information Form* or a signed statement from a medical professional confirming the need for a caregiver to reside with the tenant.
- Primary Caregiver Tax Credit *Level of Care Equivalency Guideline* form completed by a medical professional showing that the tenant requires a caregiver.

- Proof of Primary Residence Checklist* for the live-in caregiver.
- Letter from Canada Revenue Agency that the caregiver has been approved to receive the Primary Caregiver Tax Credit. Not applicable to professional caregiver such as a nurse or care worker.
